## **TRACTOR & SEMI/TRUCK TIRES** \$20.00 Per Tractor

& \$8.00 Semi Tire

Will accept tires up to 30" wide. No Combine in excess of 12-ply.

Participants will be required to provide a valid driver's license or state issued photo identification card. Limit: 10 Tires Total per Darke Co Address Per Person Per Load

To keep our collection safe & easy, we require that you do the following:

Preregister tires at the Solid Waste District Office from Wednesday, Aug. 30 through Friday, Sept. 15, 2023.

- Prepay all tire fees at preregistration on or before September 15, 2023.
- Remove all rims from tires before taking them to Rumpke on September 20, 2023.
- Keep passenger tires separate from tractor tires for easier unloading on September 20, 2023.

ACCORDING TO THE OHIO REVISED CODE ALL TIRES MUST BE SECURED AND TARPED BEFORE ARRIVING AT THE RECYCLING FACILITY UNLESS YOU HAVE AN ENCLOSED VEHICLE. **UNTARPED LOADS CAN BE REFUSED.**

ATTENTION: Even though you are on our list to participate in our TIRE COLLECTION DAY on Wednesday, September 20, 2023, from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., <u>you are not officially preregistered</u>.

As promised, we are notifying you of our next Tire Collection, and appreciate the opportunity to be of service to you. To participate, you must come into our office to preregister. We will be conducting preregistration from Wednesday, Aug 30 thru Friday, September 15, 2023. Our office is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. We absolutely <u>CANNOT PREREGISTER</u> anyone by telephone.

WE ARE SORRY FOR THE INCONVENIENCE, BUT IT IS IMPORTANT FOR YOU TO COME IN TO PREREGISTER FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- We are expecting to collect a large amount of tires and will be collecting them on one single day. Again, please do not call us.
- During preregistration, you will be assigned a specific time to take your tires to the collection site, which will prevent long lines and longer waits. We will try to accommodate a time that will be convenient for you. However, times will be assigned on a "first-come, first-served basis."
- You will be issued a preregistration form that is to be presented at the gate on Wednesday, September 20, 2023, the date that you are to bring in your tires. Without this form, you will not be admitted to the site.
- If you have signed up to bring in tires, you will need to prepay for them when you preregister. Tractor tires are \$20.00 per tire up to 30" wide and Semi/Truck Tires are \$8.00 and passenger tires are \$2, with a limit of 10 tires total. No combine tires will be accepted in excess of 12-ply.
- Passenger tires up to 17 inches, will be accepted for \$2.00 each. All tires must have the rims removed and be free of dirt and water. If you bring us tires full of dirt or water, we will send your tires back with you and not refund your payment. State law requires a transporter's permit from the Ohio EPA if you are hauling more than 10 tires. There is a limit of 10 tires, no matter the combination. (ORC 3734.83)

According to state law, all tires must be tarped and secured, which will be explained to you when you come in.

Looking forward to helping you, we will see you during the preregistration period.
